



# LEDNICE-VALTICE CULTURAL LANDSCAPE

A picnic and overnight stay among the vineyard rows, a Mediterranean atmosphere, and a glass of sparkling wine in hand? Pack your good mood, appetite for discovery, and taste for adventure, we're heading south!



Day 1

Start your journey in the famous Pálava region. On the outskirts of Pavlov, where an ancient settlement once stood, lies the architecturally unique **Archeopark** ↑. These white cubes rising from the hillside look like a sci-fi set but house a museum of prehistory. Dive into ancient times—this exhibit is fun for all ages. Afterward, take a 2-kilometer walk to the **Dívčí hrady** ruins, where two white ladies are said to haunt. Even if they don't appear,

the stunning view of the **Nové Mlýny** reservoir, where you can swim, is worth it. And of course, South Moravia means wine! **Reisten Winery** at Pálava's base will share their philosophy of respect for nature. Stay overnight at the local campsite, parking amid the vineyards—an unforgettable experience.



Day 2

Continue to **Mikulov** ↑, a town with a Mediterranean vibe. Start with a hearty breakfast or brunch—you'll need the energy. For great dining tips throughout your trip, check out the Gourmet South Moravia guide (available for free at tourist info centers across South Moravia or download it from [gourmetsouthmoravia.eu](http://gourmetsouthmoravia.eu)). After fueling up, hike to the nearby **Na Turoldu Cave**—a seven-level


cave with an emerald lake, used as a refuge since the Stone Age. Back in Mikulov, explore the **Jewish Quarter**, home to one of the largest Jewish cemeteries in the Czech Republic, a synagogue, and a ritual bath - mikveh. Don't miss the **Dietrichstein Tomb** and the **Baroque castle**, which houses the largest wine exhibition in the country. Finally, be sure to hike up to the pilgrimage site, **Svatý kopeček**.



Day 3

**Park in Lednice**—stellplatz at Annovino Winery is recommended for an overnight stay. Swap your wheels for water with a boat trip on the castle's Dyje River, offering a stunning experience. The boat can take you to the **Minaret** or **Janohrad** ↑ in the meanders of the Old Dyje. Along the way, you might spot signs of beaver activity and possibly catch a glimpse of the rare kingfisher. If you missed touring the Neo-Gothic

**Lednice Castle**, don't worry—plenty of beautiful buildings are nearby. Drive to the **Temple of Apollon**, where you can park easily, even with a camper. Enjoy a walk along the **Mlýnský Pond** and then head to **Valtice**. In the summer heat, cool off in the **Valtice Underground**, where you can also enjoy wine tasting. The best sunset views are at the **Reistna Colonnade**. And for tired feet, try the local **Barefoot Trail**.



Day 4

If you skip the tour of the **Baroque castle** ↑, don't leave Valtice without a walk through the castle park. On its edge, find the fragrant **herb garden**. On your way to Břeclav, the floodplain forests hide another romantic structure: **Rendez-vous**, also known as Diana's Temple, an Empire-style beauty related to Paris's Arc de Triomphe. Břeclav, at the edge of the Lednice-Valtice area, offers insights into the

famous local Lichtenstein family at the **Lichtenstein House**. In the Neo-Romanesque **synagogue** the vaulted ceiling evokes Versailles. For local dining tips, check out Gourmet Jižní Morava. Still have time? Explore the beautiful floodplain forests around Břeclav and follow the old Slavic paths to the extensive Slavic settlement near the Empire-style **Pohansko** hunting lodge.

# EXPLORING THE TRADITIONS OF SLOVÁCKO

A perfect itinerary for lovers of folklore and local delicacies. Get inspired, whether you're travelling with a mobile home or looking for a new destination for a weekend getaway.



Day 1

Start at the **Arboretum in Némčičky**, set in a beautiful natural setting. Enjoy a barefoot trail, a self-service refreshment stand in a cave, and plenty of games and puzzles. Then head to Čejkovice to the "Sun Gate" **Sonnenor** ↑, where the fragrant herb kingdom overlooks the rolling landscape. Learn about the company's commitment to ecology and natural resource management. Sample their specialties

in the café and let the kids explore the large garden. From Čejkovice, it's a short drive to Mutěnice, where you might taste some wines in the **local cellars (Mutěnické budy)**. Finish the day with a hike to the **Vyšicko lookout**, known locally as Triangl. The path through picturesque vineyards offers a stunning sunset view.



Day 2

After breakfast, it's time to head to **Pižve** ↑! Don't worry, we're not going snail hunting. Instead, we're off to Pižve, a charming village with a name that just happens to mean "snails" in Czech. Discover the charming white cellars with blue foundations and playful names in **Petrov** near Strážnice. Explore this picturesque cellar village, a protected architectural reserve. Wine lovers will find it hard to resist sampling many varieties here. In Petrov, you can

visit **one of the Bařův Canal's ports**, where seasonal boat trips depart. Feel adventurous? Rent a boat—no captain's license needed. Or try a scooter on the excellent bike path along the water. If you have extra time, visit **Strážnice**, known for its folklore and folk art, and check out the **castle's** vast collection of over 400 traditional musical instruments.



Day 3

Start your day in **Strážnice at the indigo dye workshop**, where you can learn about this traditional craft and even try printing ornaments yourself. Did you know indigo dyeing was added to UNESCO's intangible cultural heritage list in 2018? This Strážnice workshop is one of only two in the Czech Republic still practicing the craft. After your cultural experience, head to **Salaš Travičná** on the hill above Radějov.

It's a showcase of a natural garden with a small museum of traditional wooden buildings and many domestic animals. In September, they host the service tree (oskeruše) festival. This rare fruit, native to the White Carpathians, can be sampled on the **educational trail**. A half-kilometer walk from **Salaš** leads to the **Travičná lookout** ↑, offering a scenic loop around the memorial service tree to **Tvarožná Lhota**.



Day 4

Camping Tips:

Today, we start with something unique. It looks like the Netherlands, but it's... good old Moravia! The **windmill in Kuželov** ↑, the only Dutch-style windmill in Moravia, is sure to captivate you. Nearby, visit the **Radošov lookout tower**, shaped like a wine glass. Hungry? Stop at **Kyjov Brewery**, where you can tour the brewery, enjoy a unique menu, and even try beer baths. For more food recommendations, check out

the Gourmet Jižní Morava guide. If you loved the morning windmill, end your day at **Bukovanský mlýn**, the tallest windmill in the Czech Republic and also a lookout tower. The complex, built in traditional Slovácko style, includes a restaurant serving regional and Old Czech cuisine, as well as attractions like mini-golf, archery, and more.



Day 1

## MORAVIAN KARST AND ZNOJMO REGION

Get ready for a trip where you'll explore an area full of caves and forests north of Brno, as well as the sun-drenched Znojmo region. Focused on adventure and active experiences. Let's go!

We start north of Brno in **Boskovice**. At the local info center, choose from three tours of the town's many Jewish heritage sites. (Want a guided tour? Arrange it in advance.) The historic **Jewish quarter** includes a publicly accessible **Synagogue Maior** ↑, a ritual bath **mikveh**, and a **Jewish community house**. Strengthen your legs by climbing the **town hall tower** for stunning views, or explore the **castle ruins**

for more scenic vistas. On the way, you'll pass an **Empire-style chateau**. In the afternoon, head to Jedovnice for some nature. This spot is ideal for summer recreation and sports. Paddleboard on the large pond, or try the local **singletrails** on your own or rented bike. For dining tips in this region, check out Gourmet South Moravia.



Day 2

Day two promises an **adrenaline rush**. Embark on an adventurous **spelunking expedition in Moravian Karst!** Gear up with a helmet, headlamp, and ferrata set before descending into the underground world. Conquer narrow passages, rope ladders, and vertical drops. This challenge tests both physical and mental strength. Not for the faint-hearted! For a less intense adventure, try the escape room,

suitable for families with kids as young as four. Recharge with a hearty lunch and prepare for another thrill. Explore Moravian Karst by bike or on foot. While the **Punkevní Caves** and **Macoča** are iconic, discover hidden gems like **Balcarka** ↑, **Sloupsko-šošůvské Caves**, and **Výpustek**, each boasting impressive chambers and stunning formations. For those seeking an above-ground challenge, the **Velká Dohoda climbing area** awaits.



Day 3

For a change of pace, indulge in culture and relaxation, but don't forget your bike. **Moravský Krumlov Castle** is once again hosting the **Slav Epic** ↑, a must-see exhibition of Alfons Mucha's monumental paintings. Before continuing, recharge with local delicacies recommended by Gourmet South Moravia in **Ivančice**, Mucha's birthplace. Don't miss Ivančice asparagus when in season! In Znojmo, the new **LOUKA information center**

is your starting point for exploring the region. Cycle through the forested Dyje valley and enjoy the peaceful afternoon at **Králov Stolec viewpoint**. After nature's beauty, it's time for history. Cycle to **Znojmo's** heart in under 30 minutes. Immerse yourself in the charming medieval streets and savor the city's delicious cuisine. For a romantic sunset, head to the viewpoint at the **Rotunda of St. Catherine**.



Day 4

Where can you experience (and photograph) a sunrise worthy of a Hollywood blockbuster? Head to the viewpoint near **Vranov nad Dyjí Castle** early in the morning. We guarantee a spectacular start to your last day of this trip. This Baroque gem has been the backdrop for many films—can you recall any? Or ask your guide during the tour. Now, it's time to get moving. Have kids with you? They'll be entertained

at **Vrunoff Park** and the nearby **Vranov Beach** ↑. It may not be the sea or an Alpine lake, but you'll find the sandy beach, warm water, stunning surroundings, and fun activities from the rentals just as cool. Try paddleboarding, a boat ride, or a swing jump. If water fun isn't your thing and a good swim was enough, hop on a bike and head to the romantic **Bitov Castle** hidden in the nearby woods.
